Smaller yarding of mixed quality prime cattle had values similar to last week's sale with Steers that need another 50kgs to top off lifting by 5c/kg. Heifers around 400-450kgs eased to around \$2.10-\$2.20/kg liveweight but were of mixed quality.

Light yarding of store cattle with crossbred cattle in light condition meeting limited demand, Short term heavy stores selling well to take advantage of Spring growth.
