PRIME STEERS Steers sold from \$4.80 to a top of \$5.53/kg, with Glenlea Partnership's pen of Angus Hereford X steers (545kg) the standout. P & J Claridge's Speckle Park X steers also sold well at \$5.42/kg, with Brosnan Partnership's Speckle Park X line making \$5.39/kg. PRIME HEIFERS Heifers made from \$4.01 through to a top of \$5.58/kg, with Brosnan Partnership's Angus heifers (555kg) topping the market. Central Deer Park's Hereford heifers (675kg) and Brosnan Partnership's second line also sold strongly at \$5.44/kg. PRIME COWS AND BULLS A light cow and bull entry saw Scarborough Hill Properties' Angus cow (785kg) make \$4.41/kg, while Run 351 Ltd's Angus bull (945kg) sold to \$4.32/kg.
