WAIKAKA STATION

Nestled in New Zealand's lush green Southland region, Waikaka Station is a fifth generation family owned farm specializing in quality genetics through their renowned Hereford, Texel and Rombreed studs.

A long term passion for these breeds has seen these animals on the Paterson's property for over 100 years

740 hectares of flat to rolling pastures is home to Waikaka Genetics' Hereford herd which comprises of 200 cows with calves at foot, 40 rising two year old bulls, 8 sire bulls and 60 rising two year old heifers. Bull calves are left entire and around 55 are sold as yearlings into the dairy industry, the remainder being kept over until our onfarm sale in autumn.

The sheep flocks number 4000 breeding ewes, 1100 ewe hoggets and 150 ram hoggets which are sold each summer to clients from around the country. The flock showcases Texels and Romneys, with very successful Romex breeding which is a cross between the two providing excellent growth and carcass along with great maternal traits. Also featuring are our Romdale, Romney Perendale Cross which offer survivability and easy lambing.

Day to day running of the farm is managed by Laurie and Ross with the rest of the family lending a hand whenever needed. Stock are wintered on crops, and lambing and calving are both done outdoors in spring coincide with the grass growth curve.

Waikaka Station is also home to 3 generations of the Paterson Family who live and work the family property together.

Laurie took over the running of the farm from his parents in 1965, and has farmed it ever since alongside his wife Sharon and now his son Ross who lives here with his wife Steph and their three children, Ollie Emmie and Leo who are the 6th generation here on the property.

Ross' brother Bill has pursued his love of flying and is a helicopter pilot. He is currently living and working in Queenstown with his wife Rebecca and son Jimmy.

Visitors are always welcome at Waikaka Station, whether its a working holiday or a farm visit, our doors are always open. Feel free to get in touch and organise a time to pop in and see us or perhaps tour Sharon's passion project, Paterson Park and Gardens.

BREEDPLAN EBVs and selection indexes remove the effects of non-genetic factors (e.g. feeding regimes, animal age) from what is seen and measured to provide the best measure of an animal's genetic merit. BREEDPLAN information should always be used in conjunction with other selection criteria, including visual assessment.

A BREEDPLAN Guide to Animal Selection allows you to select the best genetics for your herd in four easy steps:

1. Identify the **New Zealand Hereford selection index** of most relevance to you.
2. **Rank animals** using the chosen selection index.
3. Consider the individual EBVs of importance.
4. Consider other traits of importance (e.g. visual assessment).

Semen collection and evaluation using electroejaculation is utilised worldwide for obtaining a semen sample and is part of our procedure to demonstrate normal reproductive ability. Xcell Breeding and Veterinary services uses this safe and reliable method using highly skilled operators with modern equipment to assist the stud breeder in his desire to present quality animals for sale. Each bull featured in this catalogue has undergone Xcell's semen evaluation and fertility test.

The evaluation consists of:

1. Palpation and examination of the testicles, the testis should be firm, equal in size with no palpable abnormality and have scrotal diameter in keeping with industry standards.
2. The penis and sheath are examined for any apparent abnormality e.g. sores, lacerations, abscesses, hair rings, warts, cork screw, penile frenulum, scar tissue, signs of damage. During stimulation the penis must extend from the sheath, straight in the midline of the bull.
3. Microscopic evaluation of a semen sample for Motility (% of live sperm within the sample) and morphology (% of normal vs. abnormal sperm within the sample).

All the above information is considered and, where there is any departure from normal the bull is either failed outright or re-evaluated at a later date.

As the testing is often done some months prior to the bull being joined, it is important to appreciate that subsequent ill health or injury may render the animal either temporarily or permanently infertile. It is important to observe young bulls working and it is good practice to back up mate with a proven sire after 2 cycles to cover the possibility of any possible subsequent temporary infertility.

HERD MANAGEMENT POLICY

At Waikaka we aim to manage the herd as closely as we can to the reality our bulls will face when on sold into the industry, given the constraints of different properties. We try to calve our cows and wean etc when other commercial breeders in our area are doing so. All cows go behind hotwires cleaning up for winter, there are no favorites! All cows have to calve as two year olds and must rear a live calf every year, once again there are no favorites! Thick well boned muscle bulls with good hair coats and soundness will ensure survivability in the some- times harsh South Island backcountry that the Hereford has made its own in the last 100 years. At the same time we have to capture the table meat market requiring 300 kg carcasses of quality fine-grained table meat and enhance our profitability by accomplishing this before the onset of the second winter, and do it off grass! These are conflicting goals and only by constant effort will we achieve them.

Our cattle operation at Waikaka is driven by profit not sentiment and we place great emphasis on lifting the performance of our lower performing cows which of course is the nuts and bolts of any commercial operation. We don't want a herd of a few stars and "the rest". There is no way you can produce even lines of steers using bulls from herds like that!

Our priorities are:

1. FERTILITY/CALVING EASE get as many calves on the ground and alive as possible.
2. GROWTH increase carcass weights to sensible goals.
3. CARCASS increase muscling in tandem with skeletal size.
4. ACHIEVE these goals with a low maintenance cowherd.

PROFIT = KG OF BEEF PER HECTARE x PRICE PER KG LESS COST OF PRODUCTION
(Feeding the cow herd etc).

GROUP BREEDPLAN

All EBV's in this catalogue are NZ 2025 APRIL GROUP BREEDPLAN GENETIC EVALUATION figures and may only be compared with other herds compared in the same Group Breedplan Run. All Hereford & Polled Hereford cattle in both Australia & NZ have been compared together. Accuracy figures provided are a reflection of the information available to make the genetic trait prediction. They describe how the estimated breeding value may vary up or down from the true breeding value. Even though the accuracy figures in some cases may be low the predictions will in most cases be spot on.

SPECKLE PARK NZ EBV's Explained

BREEDPLAN EBVs and selection indexes remove the effects of non-genetic factors (e.g. feeding regimes, animal age) from what is seen and measured to provide the best measure of an animal's genetic merit. BREEDPLAN information should always be used in conjunction with other selection criteria, including visual assessment.

A BEST PRACTICE GUIDE TO SELECTING YOUR NEXT NEW ZEALAND SPECKLE PARK SIRE

A BREEDPLAN Guide to Interpreting EBVs helps producers understand how to assess and compare the genetic merit of animals. Each EBV is reported in the units in which the measurements are taken (e.g. Weight EBVs are reported in kilograms). Please note that only EBVs produced in the same BREEDPLAN analysis can be directly compared.

When interpreting BREEDPLAN EBVs, producers may:

1. Compare to the level of genetic merit within the current population.
Comparing against the current levels of genetic merit (breed average and/or percentile bands) allows you to understand where an animal ranks within the evaluated population. EBV percentile graphs can be found online for each animals and provide a visual representation of where an animal ranks for each trait.
2. Compare expected difference in progeny performance
Comparing the expected difference in outcome if two (or more) different sires are used in a herd gives you an understanding of what these EBVs mean in real terms.
3. Consider EBV accuracy
As a general rule, animals should be compared on EBVs regardless of accuracy. Most rising two year old bulls will have similar EBV accuracy levels; however, there may be some variation (particularly at multi-vendor sales) due to levels of performance recording and/or progeny if the bull was used as a yearling.
