




#### Claas



Claas had above average beam we feel for a 2yr old, his overall style is very much the Korean Style of old – correct tyne placement, shorter tynes, then all about "BEAM". Claas had 42 hinds to mate at 2yrs, so we were more than happy with his velvet cut, given his workload.




#### Corona



5yr velvet sire Corona belongs to Lindsay Tayles. He is a large framed and big bodied stag, very casual in behaviour and cut a very good 13.2kg of velvet at 5yrs in 2021. Corona at 4yrs cut 10.82kg of velvet which claimed him second place in the 4yr section of the National Velvet Competition 2020, a Gnats whisker behind Lazarus, 140gms and 0.63 of a point separated 1st and 2nd. Corona has been residing at Tower Farms for the last three years.

Exceptional velvet weight, style and round beam length in Grafanarkis' velvet. From a total fawn drop of 22 stags in 2015, Grafanarkis had ten 3yr sons in the December 2018 Stag Sale ranging from 6.3kgs to 9.65kgs, averaging 7.31kgs. Having just returned from a sabbatical of three seasons at Tayles Deer, Grafanarkis had 50 odd hinds at 15 years and has achieved 100% in scanning so far!





This stag has exceptional velvet volume. Podium is big and black in body and velvet and very quiet to go with it. He grew a humongous 3yr head in structure, beam 32/27, 29/27, tynes and spread, with very high trezs, short above, cut only four inches, 10 and 11cm above trez, with a thumb between the left trez and beam. Interestingly his half brother by JD has the same exceptional velvet volume at 1yr, incredibly fat spikes with huge brow tynes, then cut 4kg of branching regrowth. The JD half brother mentioned above, 19 9000 was used for sire duties at 2yrs, and has offspring in this catalogue. They have excellent temperament, generally of a good size and have an attractive black coat colour.




#### Schafanacka



Schafanacka is a good sized 2yr old, out of a top Gus Schiska selected hind 16 33 by his top progeny sire at the time, #240. Schafanackas 2yr velvet of 5.45kg was a good effort given the farm, and he personally had a severe copper deficiency (fleshless velvet). His Velvet head style and confirmation is very good with excellent tyne placement.




## Lot 1 Weaner Hind 23 3014



A couple kgs under 70 kgs mid April has this Corona daughter flying, as are a number of Corona's offspring this year. Merryvale gained second place in the 2yr velvet section of the 2024 Rising Stars with a 7.72kg head and 9th and 10th with heads weighing 5.92kg and 6.82kg. 
## Lot 2 Weaner Hind 23 330







Hind 23 3054 is the only female offspring from dam 19 925, who along with dam 19 920 is a half sister to Brock Deer's Bluerock.








## Lot 7 Weaner Hind 23 369




Dam 19 9115 was a maiden 2yr hind and 22 2007 is her first fawn and only daughter, she has a R1yr stag to Corona on farm.
